ADDITION TO ST. FRANCIS CAMPUS | \$4-5 MILLION

9,000 sq. ft. addition connecting to north gathering space

- Space for expanding youth programs
- Small groups and ministry meetings
- Office and administrative expansion

ADDITION TO INCARNATION CAMPUS | \$3-5 MILLION

6,000–9,000 sq. ft. addition connecting to back of the church

- Larger gathering space
- Funeral visitations & receptions
 - Nursery for families
 - Bridal preparation space
- Flexible ministry meeting areas

EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTER | \$2.5-3 MILLION*

To be constructed on the Incarnation Campus

- Expands Preschool 4's and Early 5's
 - Supports parish school growth
 - On-site childcare for staff
- Addresses rising childcare costs and staff retention

**Tentative pending architectural studies and building code review, including possible PAC renovation.*

WHY NOW?

OCIA

- 2024: 12 candidates, All Saints Room
- 2025: 50 candidates, moved to JPll Room
- Currently near fire code capacity
- Next option conflicts with Knights of Columbus

Youth Faith Formation

- Campus-wide room usage during programming
- Awaken – 4x weekly
- EDGE – 3x weekly
- LifeTeen – 1x weekly

Adult Formation

- Enrollment exceeds capacity
- Registrations capped
- Requests for larger rooms ongoing

Boy Scouts

- Weekly Boy Scouts meetings
- Additional weekday gatherings
- Large weekend events (Pinewood Derby)

- A welcoming gathering space for Fellowship Sunday
- Space for funeral visitations and parish receptions
 - Nursery for families attending Mass
- Breakout rooms for ministry and bridal preparations

EARLY CHILDHOOD CENTER | \$2.5-3 MILLION*

To be constructed on the Incarnation Campus

- Expanded Preschool 4's and Early 5's programs
- On-site childcare for school and pastoral staff
- A solution to rising childcare costs impacting staff retention
 - A foundation for growing Catholic families

OUR MINISTRY REALITY

OCIA CONTINUES TO GROW

What began in the All Saints Room now fills the JP11 Room nearly to fire code capacity each week.

ADULT FAITH FORMATION EXCEEDS EXPECTATIONS

We frequently limit enrollment due to space constraints.

YOUTH PROGRAMS FILL ENTIRE CAMPUSES

Awaken meets four times weekly.

EDGE meets three times.

LifeTeen meets weekly.

When youth faith formation gathers, every available room is in use.

SCOUTS AND MINISTRIES THRIVE

Boy Scouts meet weekly and host large events.

More than 50 ministry and apostolate groups request space regularly.

Over 40 staff members serve daily across both campuses.

We currently have 21 total meeting rooms.
Many days and evenings, **there are none available.**

Growth is not projected - **it is happening now.**
